





Course Structure

- Elective: Global Logistics and Procurement



Transport and Port Management Major

- Mandatory: Management in Logistics, Supply Chain and Transport
- Elective: Passenger and Freight Transport Operations
- Elective: Port Operations





Course Format

- Mandatory: DIP-01 Management in Logistics and Transport
- Elective: DIP-02 Supply Chain Management
- Option: DIP-17 Supply Chain Network Planning
- Option: DIP-16 Supply Chain Flow Planning



Transport Major

Acquire a sound foundation for a career in transport with essential management and operational skills

- Mandatory: DIP-01 Management in Logistics and Transport
- Elective: DIP-03 Transport Operations
- Elective: DIP-04 Transport Planning
- Option: DIP-06 Movement of Goods
- Option: DIP-07 Movement of People





Course Format

Students are required to complete a minimum of 4 units to be awarded the CILT International Diploma. The total number of units studied will depend on the student's selected major.

Each unit is delivered through a combination of online facilitated workshops and self-paced reading and eLearning.

Assessment includes in-class participation, group presentation and an assignment.
